Education

Basic Skills Assessment

All candidates seeking teacher certification and applying for initial Instructional PK–4/SED PK-8 must take and pass the Basic Skills Assessments. Candidates must take one or a combination of the tests offered by Pearson or ETS/Praxis in the subjects of Reading, Writing, and Mathematics. Pre-service educators in the ECE PK-4 and SED PK-8 major must take the Basic Skills test before registering or entering the Teaching and Learning Blocks or methods courses and taking the PECT tests.

The following are the data on Basic Skills passing rates compiled from the latest Title II Reports (2017-2018) for all program completers: Math is 83%; Writing is 92%; Reading is 93%.

The following are the data for Pennsylvania Educator Certification Tests (PECT) passing rates compiled from the latest Title II Reports (2017-2018): Early Childhood Education PECT Module 1 is 100%, Module 2 is 90%, Module 3 is 90%. The passing rate for the Special Education PECT Module 1 is 79%, and Module 2 is 84%.

The passing rate for Secondary Education candidates is outlined below. The data provide summaries of passing rates as provided to the Pennsylvania Department of Education from Tittle II reports from 2011-2018. Teacher certification passing rates for Westminster College Secondary Education candidates are higher than the average passing rate for teacher candidates in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The average Pennsylvania certification passing rate is 77% (US Department of Education, Tittle II Higher Education Act)

Secondary Education - Biology

Due to the small number of examinees for biology content knowledge, the official report provides insufficient statistics about the rate of first time passing. In the one year with reported statistics, 80% of the students taking the biology content knowledge exam passed. To the best of our knowledge, the first-time passing rate in the other four years is 100%. This suggests that the current program of study is adequate for preparing students with sufficient background in the biology content area.

Secondary Education – Mathematics

In academic year 2016-2017, the pass rate for mathematics secondary education candidates was 100%.

Secondary Education - English

Since fall 2013, 92.8% of English majors who have taken the Praxis Content Knowledge exam passed on the first try.

<u>Nursing</u>

For Cohort 1, the pass rate on the NCLEX is 92%. (Updated January 2021)
