

**GARY D. BROWN** has served on the Westminster College Board of Trustees since 2005 and has been extensively involved with the Towering Titan Organization since its founding. As a student, he was an outstanding basketball player and in 2010 was inducted into the Titan Sports Hall of Fame.

A Pittsburgh resident, he is currently the CEO of Mount West Investments and for many years was President of Iron City Sash and Door. In addition to his volunteerism for Westminster, he has served on the regional and national boards of the Salvation Army and has helped coach basketball in area schools.

His gift to establish the All-Titan Endowment Fund and its related Challenge is part of the institution's new \$40 million comprehensive campaign, Ever Higher: The Campaign for Westminster College, and reflects the important role that high-quality athletic programs play in student development and in the life of the College.
