## CAMP DIRECTOR TAMMY SWEARINGEN



Camp Director **Tammy Swearingen** completed her 18th season as head volleyball coach at Westminster College in 2010. She brings a wealth of knowledge and experience to her current position after previously spending 16 years coaching at Youngstown State University and various area high schools. Swearingen, the 2006, 2007 and 2008 PAC Coach of the Year, has posted a record of 410-231 (.640) over the past 18 years at Westminster.

Swearingen has led the Titan volleyball program through some of the most successful seasons in the program's history. Westminster has posted 20 or more wins during 12 of her 18 seasons. Top seasons include 1994, which saw the Titans post a school-record 36 wins en route to the Keystone-Empire Collegiate Conference (KECC) title; 1997, when the Titans finished 31-8, winning the KECC and NAIA Northeast Region titles and advancing to the NAIA National Championships for the only time in the program's history; 2001, as Westminster finished 27-8 overall with a 10-0 mark against PAC competition and captured the school's first-ever ECAC Division II Championship; 2002, which saw the Titans finish 26-10 while winning its first PAC title with a 12-0 mark; and the last two seasons, 2007 and 2008 with the Titans winning PAC titles and qualifying for the NCAA Division III Tournament for the first two times in team history.

Coach Swearingen has coached two All-Americans: **Heidi Jorgensen** in 1994 and **Janie Cebula** in 1995.

## ASSISTANT CAMP DIRECTORS BRANDON LEWIS AND SHANNON LIPOSKY



**Brandon Lewis** completed his 14th season as assistant volleyball coach at Westminster College in 2010.

Lewis brings several years of volleyball experience to his current position as assistant camp director. After playing scholastically at Farrell High School and collegiately at Ohio State University, he has coached at Hubbard (Ohio) High School as well as at several summer camps in the region. He has also spent time as a volleyball official.



**Shannon Liposky** completed her fourth year as an assistant coach for the Titan volleyball program in 2010.

Liposky played at Westminster before graduating in 2002. She was the team MVP in 2001 when the Titans compiled a 27-8 record.

## Titan Volleyball Camp July 6-9

This camp is intended for girls in grades 7-12. The objective is to provide quality skill instruction, competitive team play, promote good sportsmanship, and encourage teamwork. ### Meals

Meals begin with July 7 breakfast and conclude with lunch on July 9 ... Commuters will receive lunch and dinner daily.

### Facilities

Camp will be conducted in Westminster College's Buzz Ridl Field House Gymnasium. Five courts will be dedicated to the camp as well as utilizing the Westminster College Natatorium.

### Housing

Resident campers will be housed in the college dorms with 24-hour supervision.

## Half-Day Skills Clinics July 6 and 10

July 6 — 1 to 4 p.m.: **Defense** - Instruction will focus on defensive skill technique such as footwork, passing platform, and emergency skills.

July 10 — 1 to 4 p.m.: **Setting (Gym #1)** - Instruction will focus on setting skills such as footwork, point of contact and release, set placement, and running an offense.

July 10 — 1 to 4 p.m.: **Hitting (Gym #2)** - Instruction will focus on hitting skills such as approach footwork, arm swing, and different types of attacks.

July 10 — 5 to 7 p.m.: Geared toward high school and junior high school coaches. Instruction will focus on skills and drills. (If you send 10 athletes from your school to any of our camps you can attend the Coaches Clinic on us!)
