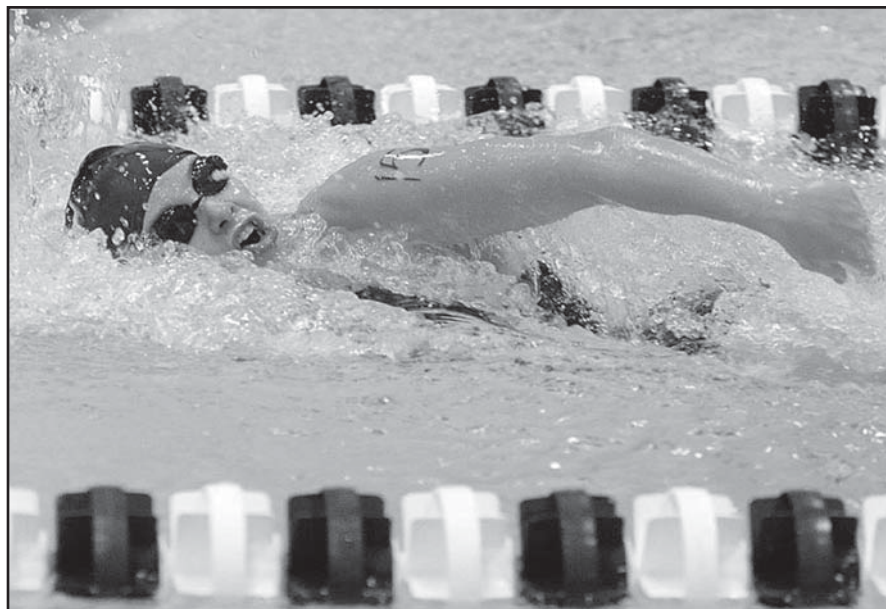

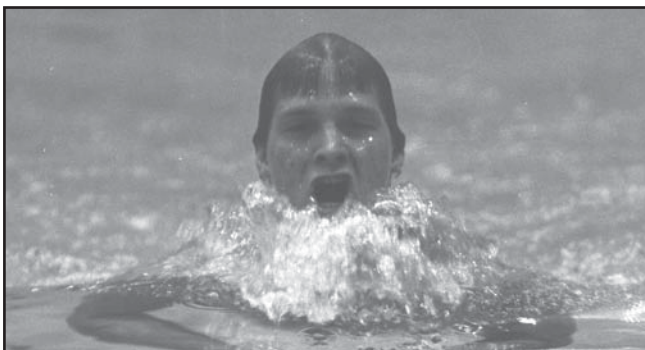

Kristen Zukowski

Kristen Zukowski stunned the 1991 NAIA 100-yard butterfly finalists when, as a freshman, she swam a school-record time of 58.37 to earn head coach Rob Klamut his first-ever national champion. Kristen walked away from the meet with All-America honors and school-record times in eight events (including five relays). The 1994 Westminster graduate was a 32-time All-American.



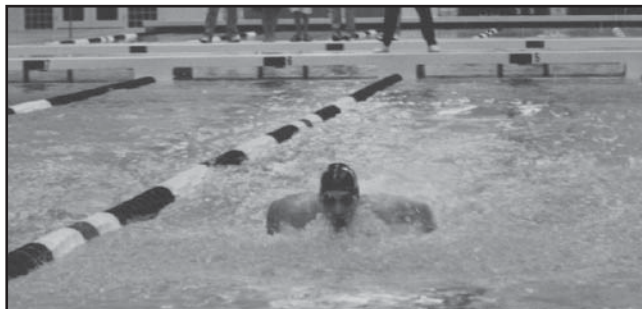
Myron Luthringer

Myron Luthringer became Westminster's first national champion in 1981, when he swam a 1:06.04 in the 100-meter breaststroke at the NAIA finals at William Jewell (Mo.) College. Luthringer, coached by Gene Nicholson, went on to earn NAIA All-America recognition in nine events.



Drew Dugan

Drew Dugan, a 16-time All-American, became the first Westminster swimmer to earn two NAIA national championships in the same year. In 1994, as a sophomore, Dugan won the 100-yard butterfly (50.64) and the 200-yard butterfly (1:53.69). Coached by Rob Klamut, he set five Westminster records and was named the NAIA Male Swimmer of the Year.



Dave Gesacion

Westminster's most recent national champion is Dave Gesacion, a 2000 graduate. At the 1998 NAIA national championships in Tacoma, Wash., Gesacion became the fourth swimmer in school history to capture a national crown with a time of 1:54.89 in the 200 butterfly. His time edged two-time defending national champion Brad Algieri of Findlay by .02. Gesacion was named Team MVP each of his four seasons and is a 23-time All-American. He became the school's first-ever NCAA Division II All-American in 1999, earning four All-America honors. As a senior in 2000, he again earned four NCAA Division II All-America laurels.

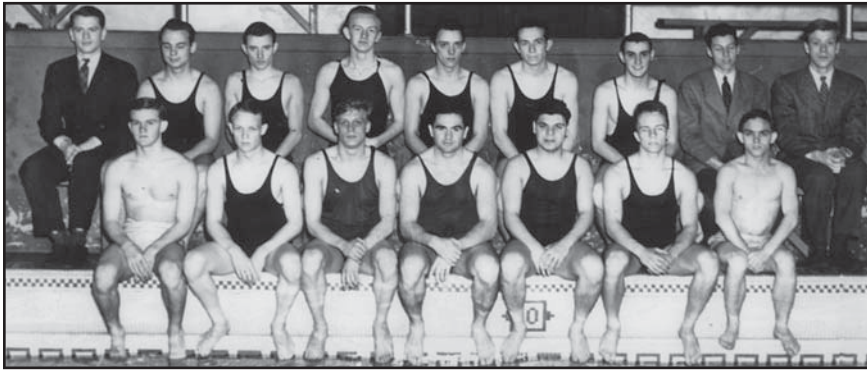
