- 1. Photo: Make sure to include one; dress and smile nice!!
- **2. Headline**: Inform people what you're excited about and what you want to do in the future.
- **3. Summary**: Describe what motivates you, your skills, and what's next. (And don't forget your passions!)
- **4. Experience**: List the jobs you held and what you accomplished at each.
- **5. Organizations**: Include everything you are involved with at WC and what you do/did with each organization
- **6. Engagement**: Have you posted, reposted, or followed companies/groups that align with your interests?
