Westminster College NCUR Application Timeline 2019/2020:

November 2nd: Deadline for student to submit Funding Application Form to Drinko Center.

November 2- November 6th: Drinko Center and the URAC committee review applications, consulting with Faculty Mentor if needed. November 9th: Drinko Center Notifies student applicants of their award status.

December 1st 2020: Deadline for travel awardees to complete the online NCUR application and abstract submission https://apps.cur.org/ncur2021/account/

January 15th 2021: NCUR Notification of Decision on Abstracts.

January 31st 2021: Deadline for Early Bird Conference Registration: Coordinate with Drinko Center

February and March 2021: Westminster NCUR Participant Informational Meetings

April 2021: NCUR Conference Online

PART 1: Guidelines

Eligibility and Conditions

The student must be enrolled as a degree-seeking student at Westminster College at the time of the conference and be in good academic standing.

The student must make a presentation at NCUR and participate in aspects of the virtual event beyond their individual presentation.

Projects must be conducted under the mentorship of Westminster College faculty.

To receive NCUR funding, a completed NCUR Travel Grant Application must be submitted following the deadlines delineated above.

Award recipients are required to participate in the Undergraduate Research & Arts Celebration in the year of their grant.

Students who fail to participate NCUR or URAC will be responsible for paying back their grant to the college in full.
