WELCOME TO URAC 2021!



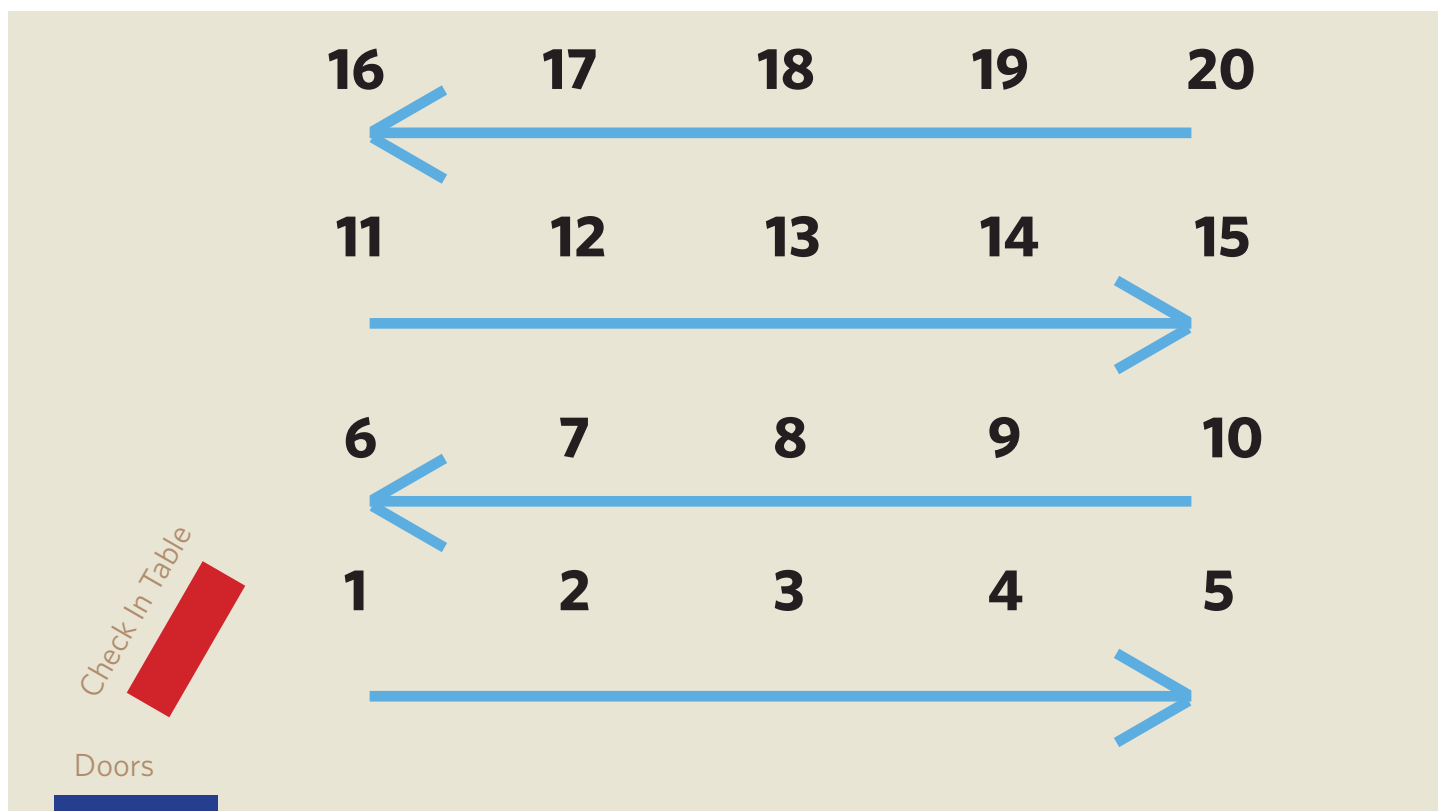
